Rob, along with his partner Lucy, run a company called One Dance Collective where they direct and coordinate artist development weeks as well as performance and training opportunities. They have put on multiple showings of work created individually and together.

Rob is not only a passionate dancer and choreographer, but a very well-respected teacher across Australia and overseas.
